Fire Safety Information

All premises of the Faculty of Law are equipped with automatic fire alarms. Fire alarms are given via metal bells.

In the event of a fire alarm, the building must be evacuated immediately!

Each floor has at least two escape routes marked with green signs. Take a moment to locate these every time you enter a new room. The escape routes are also marked on posted evacuation maps. Never use an elevator during evacuation!

In case of fire:

- 1. Rescue those in immediate danger.
- 2. Alert the fire brigade; dial 112.
- 3. Warn others threatened by the fire.
- 4. Extinguish the fire if it is deemed possible.
- 5. Close the doors to contain the fire.
- 6. Evacuate the building via the nearest escape route. Remember that the nearest escape route is not always the route you normally use.
- 7. Proceed to the designated assembly point which is the walkway outside Mormors bageri, Knut den Stores gata. See the picture below.



- 8. Look out for the evacuation leaders wearing yellow vests at the designated assembly point. It is the evacuation leaders who announce when it is safe to re-enter the building.
- 9. Do not enter the building until the evacuation leaders have announced that it is safe. Keep in mind that the condition may have worsened since you left the building.

Please note that there is a total ban on smoking in and around all university buildings.
